Where We've Been...



Goal:

To increase Farm to ECE activities across MN by providing training and technical support to local public health (SHIP) staff

Strategies:

- ✧ Collect data through surveys, interviews
- ✧ Determine needs and gaps in knowledge and/or resources
- ✧ Test adaptation of existing resources



Year 1 Successes



- ✧ **Statewide data** from local-level public health staff on Farm to ECE was catalyst for work of mini-Collin team and:
 - ✧ Data revealed need for more **Farm to ECE-focused trainings** for public health practitioners/providers
 - ✧ Gap in easy to use, “grab and go” **curriculum materials** for providers
 - ✧ Need for more general **Farm to ECE language** in existing materials, including local public health (SHIP) implementation guide
